Who's Ready for the Ride? - Indications and Contraindications

Patient selection is like choosing the right driver and car. Some are ready for the race, and others are better in the pit lane. Here, we'll outline what makes a patient appropriate for the race and we will find ways how to make them ready for the surgery.

PRE-RACE DIAGNOSTICS - PREOPERATIVE ASSESSMENT

Radiographic and Clinical Evaluation - Scouting the Route

Lateral Window Approach - The Formula 1

This approach requires precision, just like a well-timed drift. We'll break down each step to make your technique smooth and controlled.

Crestal Approach - The Drag Racing

When the situation allows for a faster approach, the crestal technique comes in handy. We'll discuss when and how to "speed through" this technique effectively.

Choosing the Right Fuel - Grafting Material Options

Just as drivers select the right fuel for their cars, surgeons must select the right grafting material. We'll discuss Xenografts, Synthetic grafts, Injectable grafts, and even no grafts!

Steering Through Techniques

The Terrain Gets Tougher

When sinus anatomy is severely atrophic, it's like driving off-road. We'll cover modifications to handle the "rougher terrain" of complex sinus cases.

Sinus Floor Elevation with Implant Placement - Timing is Everything

Like perfectly timed gear shifts, the sequence of sinus lifts and implant placements is key. We'll cover when to "accelerate" and when to hold back for best outcomes.

202 AVOIDING ROADBLOCKS - COMPLICATIONS AND MANAGEMENT

Identifying Hazards

Complications are like potholes in the race – knowing how to anticipate and avoid them is key. We'll go through common "road hazards" like membrane perforation and how to stay on track.

Prof. Park studied Periodontology at Yonsei Uni. He acquired a PhD from the same institute and researched on stem cells acquired from inflamed periodontal ligaments. He won the 2013 André Schroeder Research Prize for his studies on the isolation and characterisation of alveolar bone-derived stromal cells obtained using implant osteotomy. In 2014-2021, he served as Chair of Periodontology at Dankook Uni.

Nowadays, he focuses on his private practice at Yonsei Goodday Dental Hospital in Seoul, but he continues his path as an educator through adjunct roles at Catholic Uni. of Korea and Dankook Uni.

An associate editor for the Journal of Periodontal and Implant Science and an ITI Study Club co-director, Prof. Park has delivered 100+ lectures worldwide on implant dentistry and periodontology.
